Dear Parents,
Dear Students,

As a means to proceed to circular 7816 imposing code RED, our school will insist on *presential teaching, essential topics, sanitary protection*.

1/ FIRST DEGREE :

Classes will be organized in complete groups and all classes will be present 5 days/week.

2/ SECOND & THIRD DEGREES :

We will welcome half classes (hybridation) alternately according to the following scheme

Groupe A a half group (+1 if uneven number of students)

Groupe B, second half

For example : classe of 23 : A = 12, B= 11. Classe of 26 = 13 + 13.

→ On Friday, students will be informed about which group they belong to.

NO CHANGE will be allowed. There is no point in asking.

Organisation is already complex enough, we will kindly ask you to comply to the new rules so that the 5 coming weeks happen smoothly and in all serenity.

School attendance is *in person*. In case of non-attendance, a justification is necessary.

We insist on:

Essential topics and presential

This means that the teaching of new subjects will be done face-to-face *only* and that the use of Smartschool will be moderate.

We will avoid uploading theoretical material on Smartschool and we will only provide teaching of new subjects in person. Exercises, readings, corrective measures, ..., will be given at school for homework.

We thus ensure that your schooling does not depend in a significant way on the use of digital technology because we know that access to the computer, at specific time, for long periods, in conditions of calm, is not feasible for everyone and is not recommended for the students' well-being.

Therefore, please note that the interviews will only take place in person and therefore in two groups. So there will be no excuses for not participating.

In case of absence, you will be required, as it has already been communicated previously, to keep yourself informed through the online class journal. You may be asked to do exercises that the teacher sends to you as a learning support. In any case, you will need to keep up to date with the topics covered in class and get back in order immediately upon your return to class.

3/ For all

A) Sanitary reminder

You should have at least one clean, spare mask with you **every day**.

You must also have a personal bottle of **disinfectant** that you use in order to disinfect your hands: before and after breaks, meals; and after going to the toilet.

B) New sanitary rules due to CODE RED

The ministerial note dictates this for midday meals:

'Meals are taken with the members of the class group, in the classroom, respecting as much as possible physical distance when the mask is not worn. It

must be a meal brought by the student. No meals can be served. 'Circ 7816 p7

We are also invited to avoid massive regroupings and unnecessary movements.

→ Indeed ;

- Meals will be taken in class ;
- the drinks and biscuits dispensers will no longer be accessible;
- The selling of pasta, sandwiches, soup and fries is cancelled.

You must take your midday snacks and lunch to school.

It is necessary to provide a large napkin or a towel as a placemat to put on your desk in order to keep it clean.

In 4-5-6, students go downstairs **in line** on time and **exit** in the correct order.

It is well requested in the circular to remind you to keep the distances and the disinfection gestures when you are outside.

- The 5th hour will end 15 minutes earlier so that you can eat in class, then, in a row and accompanied by your teacher, you can reach the park and thus benefit from sufficient time in the open air. Or the teacher finishes his hour but resets twenty minutes more for the meal.
- Classes will be ventilated during lunch and during the lunch break.
- For breaks in rainy weather, we have set up 8 “SNJ” tents in the park (i.e. 200m² on the ground) so that you are protected from the rain during breaks. You will not be allowed to stay inside the building.
